

# Cannabis Creative Submission Guide

**Purpose:** To provide a step by step guide leading artist through the online submission process.

**Procedure:**

1. Go to <https://maryland.cannabiscreativebook.com/submissions>
2. Scroll Down to the Art Submission Form
3. Complete the Art Submission Form
  - a. Name
  - b. Address
  - c. Phone
  - d. Email
  - e. MMCC Patient ID # & Exp.
    - i. In the event that the artist is not a Medical Cannabis user, such as caregivers, CBD users, or artists who only create art with cannabis as the subject matter;
    - ii. Please Enter CBD, Caregiver, or N/A to indicate that this is not an issue.
4. Click Next
5. Name of Artwork
6. Select the artistic format or medium
7. Name of strain or product
  - a. N/A if not applicable
8. Cultivator, Processor or Brand of Product
  - a. N/A in not applicable
9. Medical dispensary
  - a. Leave blank if not applicable
10. Description of art:
  - a. In your own words please give a brief description of the artwork and what it signifies to you
11. How did cannabis play a role in the creation of the art:
  - a. Please describe how the artwork is related to cannabis. This could be as the subject matter, or how cannabis was inspiring to the piece, or how cannabis facilitated or enabled the creation of the artwork in some way. This is your story of how cannabis relates to the art in any way that is meaningful to you.
12. Upload the Artwork. (up to 3 images, each no more than 5 MB)

**Submission Requirements**

- Submissions may include: paintings, drawings, sculpture, murals, glasswork, woodwork, fiberwork, metalwork, prose, music, comedy, dance, theater, transformational success story, or similar work that is inspired by the most beautiful and positive aspects of cannabis;
- Art should represent creative brilliance and positivity in its message;
- Artist must be able to grant legal permission to use all materials and content you submit on our website / or acknowledge no intellectual property (IP) exist that would prohibit our use of your artwork;
- There is a significant connection to your inspiration as an artist and a cannabis product;
- All cannabis products were legally obtained and consumed in Maryland in accordance with the MMCC. A valid MMCC Patient ID is required for all submissions, with the exception of DTC CBD nutraceuticals;
- Linked to a particular strain or product by a specific cultivator, or processor, and dispensary within your state (Optional, but highly encouraged as we will include the strain name, lineage, cultivator images, and lab profile for each entry).
